WHEREAS, every year on October 29, Turkey celebrates Republic Day, commemorating the day when Turkey became an independent republic and a western democracy; and

WHEREAS, Turkish Americans enrich the economy and cultural heritage of the State of Alabama with their diversity, including culture, arts, literature, cuisine, music, folkdances, ancient and modern history, tradition of tolerance, and religion; and

WHEREAS, Turkey is the featured country of the Birmingham International Center Spotlight Program, 2010-2011, jointly with the Turkish American Association of Alabama and Assembly of Turkish American Associations; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That the Republic of Turkey is herein honored as one of the most important strategic partners of the United States, and the government and the people of Turkey are congratulated for strengthening its democracy and becoming a source of stability and inspiration in its region.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That by copy of this resolution for appropriate presentation and display, the celebration of Turkish American Heritage Day in the State of Alabama on October 29, 2011, is recognized and commended.
